Cape Vidal falls within the St Lucia Marine Reserve and is situated north-east of St Lucia within the Isimangaliso Wetland Park World Heritage Site.

Cape Vidal has the best of both worlds with access to the eastern shores of Lake St Lucia where there is a variety of game including reedbuck, antelope, hippos, crocodiles and buffalo, spectacular water, forest and grassland birds and the wonderful Indian Ocean shore line with its startling array of marine animals. The marine habitat is the route used by humpback whales on their northerly migration to Mozambique to calve.

Marine studies on the coastal Rocky shores - including some snorkelling in a protected bay. A guide provides goggles to explore the deep rock pools and examines the inter-tidal zone in detail. The sandy shore and coastal forest can be included in the lesson.

**Educational walk in Nature Reserve and beach walk +- 2hrs @ R20 per person(St Lucia)**

Nature walks within the iSimangaliso Wetland Park - focus area - Ecology, Ecosystems, Biomes, Geology and Weather/Climate, Mammals and Animal behaviour. View magnificent mangrove and swamp forests, grasslands, pans and big game on foot. There are several trails accessing the various eco-systems for which the area is famous. Utilise the beach for a fun filled session of games and swimming.

**Crocodile and Hippo Boat Cruise on the St Lucia Estuary +- 2hrs @ R100 per person(ST)**

The cruise offers good sightings of hippo, crocodiles and water birds. A guide explains the importance of the 40km long lake and 20km long tidal channel as a nursery and feeding ground for birds and marine, estuarine and freshwater fish and organisms.

**Crocodile Centre +- 3hrs @ R50 per person\_\*(R70 per learner & R90 per adult)(St Lucia)**

Get a close up view of four different crocodile species and several types of snakes. The guide will keep the students captivated for two hours with an in-depth examination of these fascinating creatures.

**Zulu Dancers +- 2 hrs @ R1000.00 per group(Futululu Park)**

Get an insight into the traditional Zulu culture on a Cultural Tour. The Zulu Nation is known for their rich culture. They are famous for their rhythmic dancing, especially the 'Reed Dance.

**Star Gazing +-3hrs @ R50 per learner(Futululu Park)**

Presented by Wildside Safaris @ Futululu Park- Learners get to glance at the universe and discover the night sky through very strong telescopes.

Whether it is your first time stargazing or not, we guarantee to leave you wanting more. Away from the bright city lights, the clear unpolluted skies of the Zululand offer awesome opportunities to *stargaze!*

For inquiring minds searching for knowledge and a bit of magic, or just a recharge of the soul, this is one of the most rewarding and fascinating activities on offer. Stargazing gives you the chance to learn about and understand the great city of stars in which we live.

The activity is ideally suited for young learning individuals as we combine an evening of learning with a fun captivating activity.

The whole evening starts off with in depth and a PowerPoint presentation talk about the universe, planets, stars, galaxies and more... The first half of stargazing is designed as a formal setting in which learners can absorb much of the information needed without the distraction of the telescope, lasers or flashlights.

Here we cover topics that are relevant to the current schooling curriculum and give opportunity for the learners to ask questions and get comfortable with us. We keep the information interactive so that the learners never feel bored or left out.

**UNIZULU Science Centre +- 4hrs @ R20 per learner/teacher(Richards Bay)**

UNIZULU's internationally acclaimed Science Centre celebrated its 25 Anniversary in 2011 along with the launch of its early childhood development museum, a first for Africa. Located within the Zululand Chamber of Business Foundation (ZCBF) Community Park in Richards Bay, the Centre has received numerous accolades for promoting interest in Science, Engineering and Technology and is home to more than 130 innovative exhibits produced locally and abroad. The Centre forms part of the University's community outreach initiative that is focused on developing inquiring minds.

**Richards Bay Harbour Tour +-1hr @ R150 per person(Richards Bay)**

We do a 1 hour harbour boat cruise for school children – telling them all about the functionality of this working harbour, and the factories surrounding, and then we also do a marine mammal talk with the kids.

**Cheese Farm+-2 hrs @R50 per learner/teacher(Including a light meal)(R618)**
